Dementia Awareness training

9th February 2012

1 day course

Venue: Deeside Enterprise Centre, Rowley's Drive, Shotton, Deeside, CH5 1PP. Training delivered by Rhoda Highton of the Alzheimer's Society

This course is suitable for anyone who comes into contact with people with dementia, but does not offer regular support to people living with the condition. It offers an insight into the everyday experience of people with dementia. It looks at how a person may be affected physically by dementia, as well as the signs, symptoms, impact of, and treatment of dementia. The course is designed for those requiring the basics of understanding dementia.

WRAP Training – Wellness and Recovery Action Planning suitable for those working in a mental health environment and service users.

2 day course

2 day workshop includes the key concepts and values of Recovery and WRAP. It explores Wellness Recovery Action Planning and the dynamism of WRAP through "crisis" as an opportunity for growth. Participants write their own Wellness Recovery Action Plan when working with individuals, organisations and communities.

Personal Safety and Lone Working

The aim of the course is to enable participants to explore the practical and emotional issues relating to lone working in a safe environment with opportunities to share and build on good practice.

The course is suitable for anyone who works in a lone working environment either in the community; in an office context, or for those who manage lone workers. These may include outreach workers, community development workers, support/advocacy workers, those meeting or supporting service providers in an office where they are alone and not in regular contact with other office users or those who transport service users alone.
